Job Title: Night Security Worker

Department: Maintenance

Reports to: Nigh Security Supervisor

Key Areas of Responsibility:

- Performs minor repairs to interior and exterior structures, electrical, plumbing, and heating and hot water systems.
- Provides overnight security by patrolling grounds and buildings.
- Checks maintenance request box at the main office at the beginning of the shift.
- Periodically checks in at the front desk for maintenance or security requests.
- Prevents theft, damage, or misuse of property; protects items on facility grounds; prevents loitering.
- Patrols grounds and makes a floor-by-floor check of buildings to detect security issues.
- Inspects buildings to assure that they are properly secured.
- Checks buildings and equipment to detect and prevent fire hazards.
- Turns lights on grounds on and off.
- Acts as the first point of contact in emergency situations and follows standard emergency procedures.
- Notifies police, fire department, or other appropriate authority of any situation requiring immediate or prompt attention.
- Troubleshoots any equipment operational problems and refers to appropriate personnel.
- Periodically checks refrigeration and ice making equipment.
- Completes repairs or replacements as assigned.
- Calls in Maintenance or Facilities Manager when needed.
- Assists guests by answering phones, taking messages, responding to request, or showing guests to their rooms.
- Stocks wood at fireplace locations and starts and maintains fire in fireplaces.
- Assists maintenance manager with water system responsibilities.
- Gathers trash from various buildings and hauls to dumpsters.
- Builds campfire for Saturday night bonfire.
- Stocks coal and removes coal cinders from the Bake Shop oven.
- Cleans fish for breakfast if needed.
- Other duties as needed to support other departments and overall operations.

• Experience in security or a related field is preferred.

Training:
