- Hoes, weeds, and uses rototiller.
- Maintains health of plantings by weeding, feeding, watering, and trimming.
- Monitors pest and animal damage and implements appropriate controls when needed.
- Plants shrubs, hedges, and small trees. Maintains health by pruning and shaping, feeding, watering, and mulching.
- Watering of plants and shrubbery during dry periods.
- Weeding and application of weed killers.
- Removes trash and litter from grounds.
- Cleans and organizes tools and gardener's shop area.
- Assumes additional duties as needed.
