Capon housekeepers are responsible for ensuring guest rooms and other interior areas of the resort are maintained in a clean and sanitary condition while approaching all encounters with guests in a friendly and courteous manner.

Key Areas of Responsibility:

- Cleans guest rooms by dusting, vacuuming, changing bed and bath linens, emptying trash, and restocking room supplies.
- Checks bedspreads, blankets, and mattress pads for cleanliness and replaces if soiled.
- Checks between mattresses and under the bed and cleans as needed.
- Cleans and disinfects shower walls and tubs, sinks, toilets, and floors in bathrooms.
- Cleans windows, doors, walls, closets and fixtures in guest rooms and public areas including hallways and public bathrooms.
- Dusts and polishes furniture, fixtures, wall hangings, and vents.
- Vacuums public areas and hallways, lifting or moving furniture to vacuum underneath.
- Realigns furniture and amenities according to prescribed room layout.
- Practices safety standards and follows all training procedures.
- Notifies supervisor/manager of any safety hazards or items that need to be replaced or repaired.
- Follows procedures for lost and found items.
- Cleans, disinfects, and stores all equipment at the end of each shift.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education:

• High School diploma or equivalent preferred.

Knowledge and Characteristics:

- Ability to multi-task and work in a fast-paced environment.
- High level of attention to detail.
- Ability to read, write, and follow oral and written instructions.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to maintain a positive and productive working relationship with co-workers.
- Valid driver's license and a clean driving record required if operating company owned vehicles including golf carts or utility vehicles.

Terms of Employment:
