Key Areas of Responsibility:

- Provides resort security by patrolling grounds and buildings.
- Performs minor repairs to interior and exterior structures, electrical, plumbing, and heating and hot water systems.
- Checks maintenance request box at the main office at the beginning of the shift and periodically checks in at the front desk for maintenance/security requests.
- Prevents the theft, damage, or misuse of property; protects items on facility grounds; prevents loitering.
- Patrol's grounds and makes a floor-by-floor check of buildings to detect security issues.
- Inspects buildings to assure that they are properly secured and to detect and prevent fire hazards.
- Acts as the first point of contact in emergency situations and follows standard emergency procedures. Notifies police, fire department, or other appropriate authority of situations requiring immediate attention.
- Periodically checks equipment and troubleshoots any operational problems. Completes repairs or replacement as assigned.
